- d) In our opinion the Balance Sheet, the Income and expenditure account and the Receipts & Payments Account comply with the Accounting Standards to the extent applicable.

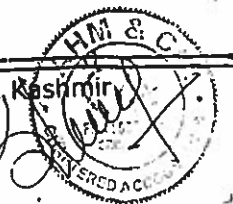

Details of the contributions received, in excess of rupees twenty thousand, during the Financial Year 2023-24as;

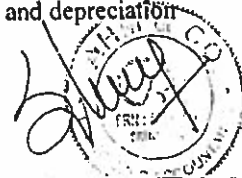
